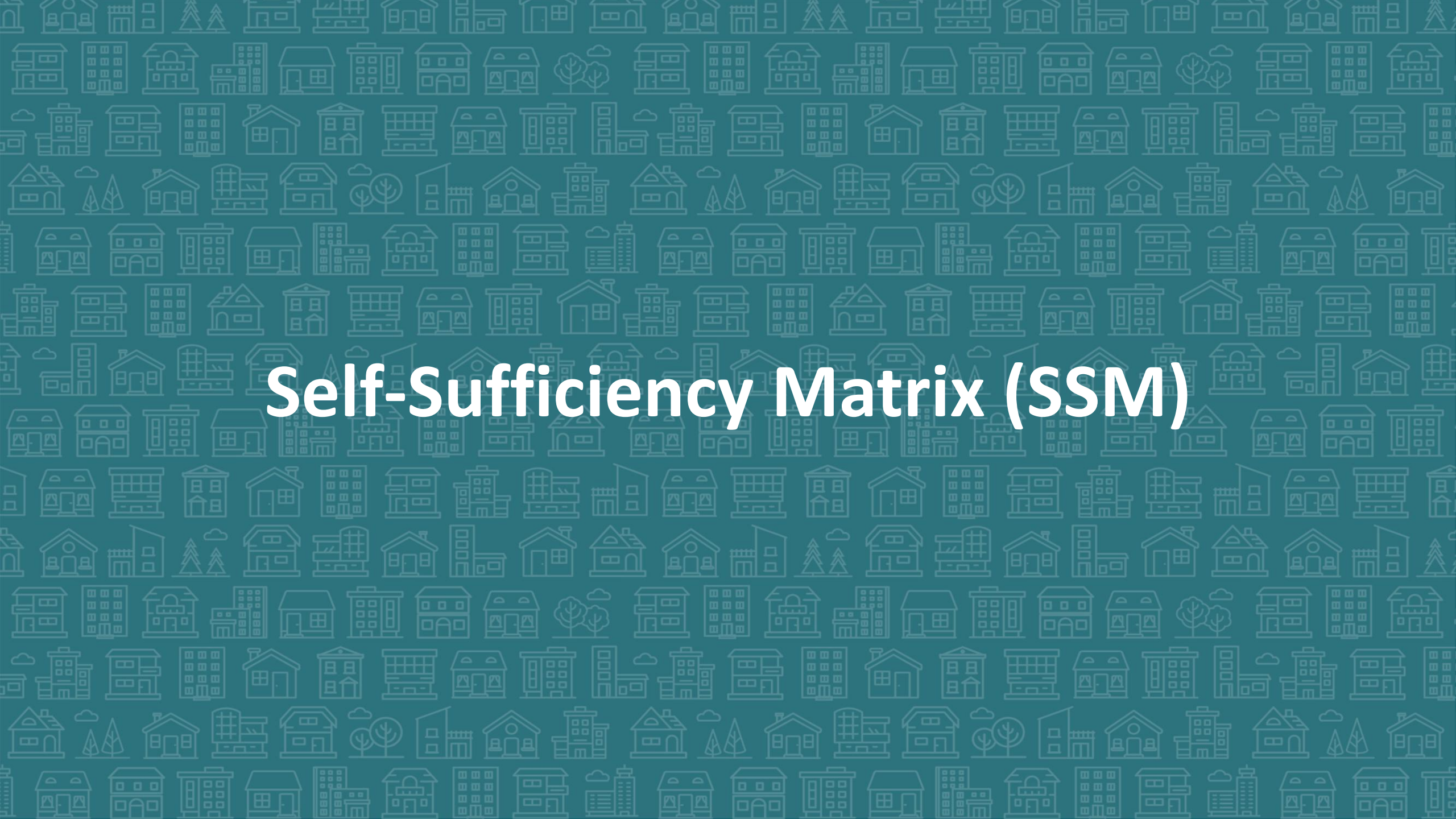

- Use up to 18 domains
- Meant for Adults only
- Clients' status on each domain is measured on a 5 point scale

2	Vulnerable
3	Safe
4	Building Capacity
5	Empowered
